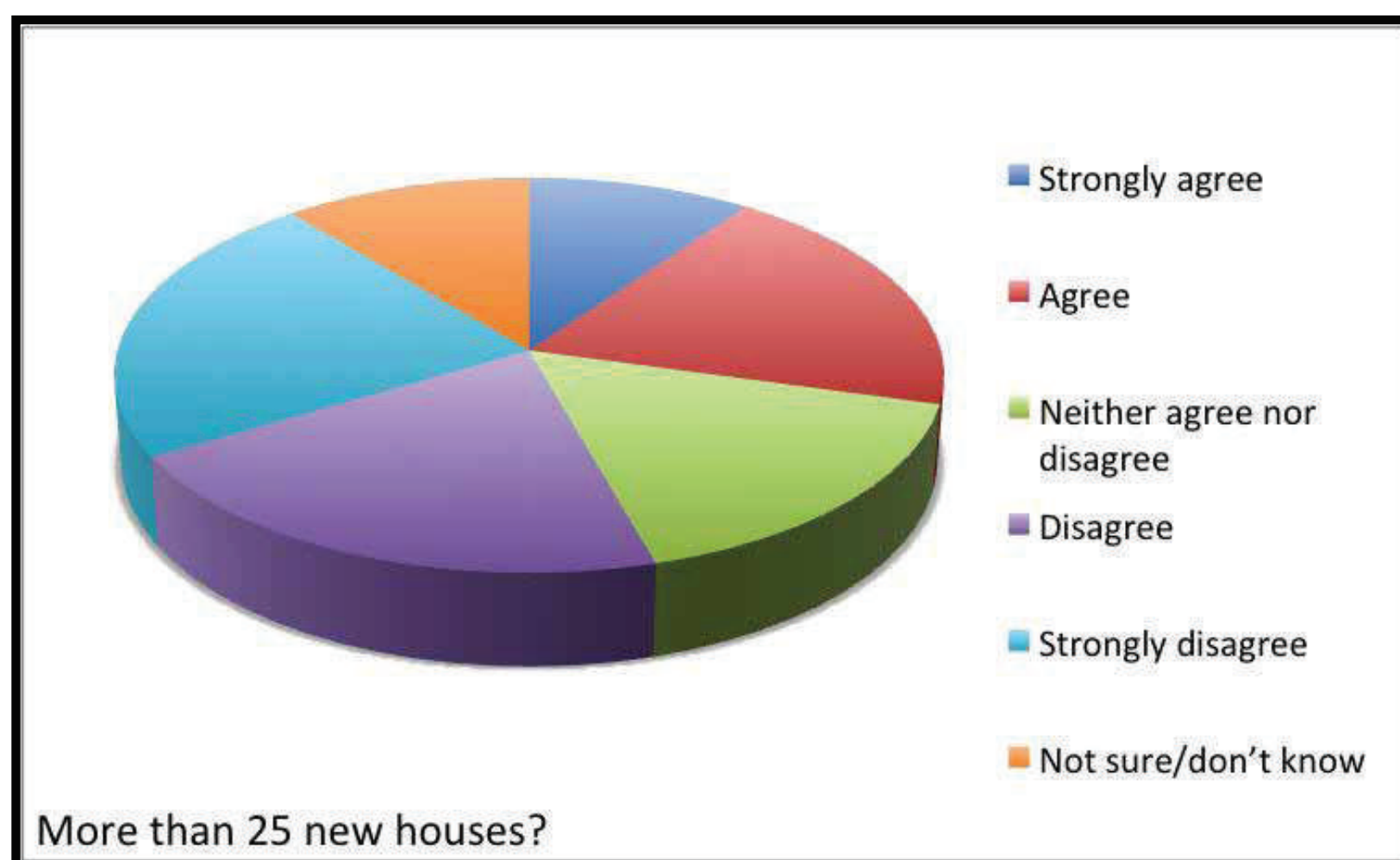


# Housing

The Lewes District Plan says at least 25 new houses have to be built in Ditchling by 2030, although there is nothing to stop developers applying to build more. There is no allocation for Streat or Westmeston.

We asked if we need more than 25 houses. 43% of residents think we don't.



Of the 30% of residents who were in favour of building more than 25 houses, two-thirds would opt for a limit of 40 dwellings.

Most people think new houses should be smaller ones for purchase and affordable houses for rent by people from the community. There is support for retirement and sheltered housing, but less support for the building of care homes or larger houses.
